The College of Registered Psychotherapists of Ontario is the regulatory body established by the provincial government to oversee the practice of registered psychotherapists in Ontario. The College is responsible for protecting and serving the public interest by ensuring that registrants provide high quality, competent and ethical services.

In Ontario, only registrants of six regulatory colleges¹ may refer to themselves as a psychotherapist or use any abbreviation of the title.

The College is currently investigating the conduct of John Robert Field. The Inquiries, Complaints and Reports Committee has suspended Mr. Field's registration pending the outcome of the investigation. An interim suspension is imposed where a registrant's conduct exposes or is likely to expose their clients to harm or injury.

John Robert Field resigned from CRPO effective August 26, 2021. Former registrants are not permitted to practise psychotherapy, use the title "psychotherapist", or hold themselves out as qualified to practise as a psychotherapist.
